


Structure of FP 7 EC & EURATOM (state: 4/6/2005)

- EP: 3rd Working papers by Rapporteur Buzek (10 Dec 2005)

- Time for amendments until end of January 2006
- Voting in ITRE-Committee in February 2006
- Voting in plenary (end of 1st reading) in March or early April 2005
- <u>EC: Adapted proposal on FP 7 after agreement on Financial</u> <u>Perspective</u>
